DOWNLOADING AND EXTRACTING THE FONT

1. Click on the link to download the compressed file containing the font (zip file).







2. Save the compressed file.

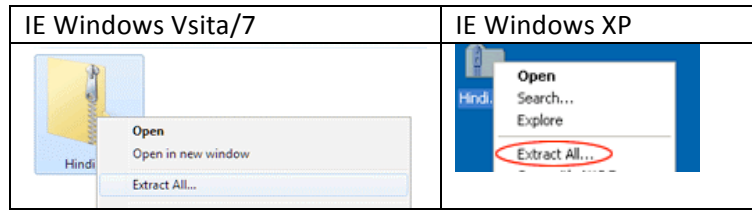

<p>To download the file to the default location (usually the Downloads folder) click “Save” or “Save As” if you want to choose the location to download the zip file.</p>	<p>Click “Save” and select where you want to download the file.</p> 	<p>Select “Save file” and click ok.</p>	

NOTE: The default location on Windows Vista/7 is the “Downloads” library. On Windows XP is the Desktop.

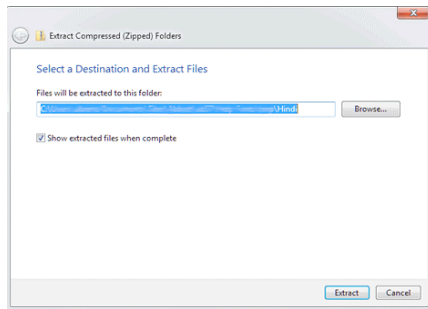
3. Open the folder where you downloaded the zip file.

4. Right click on the zip file, select "Extract All..."

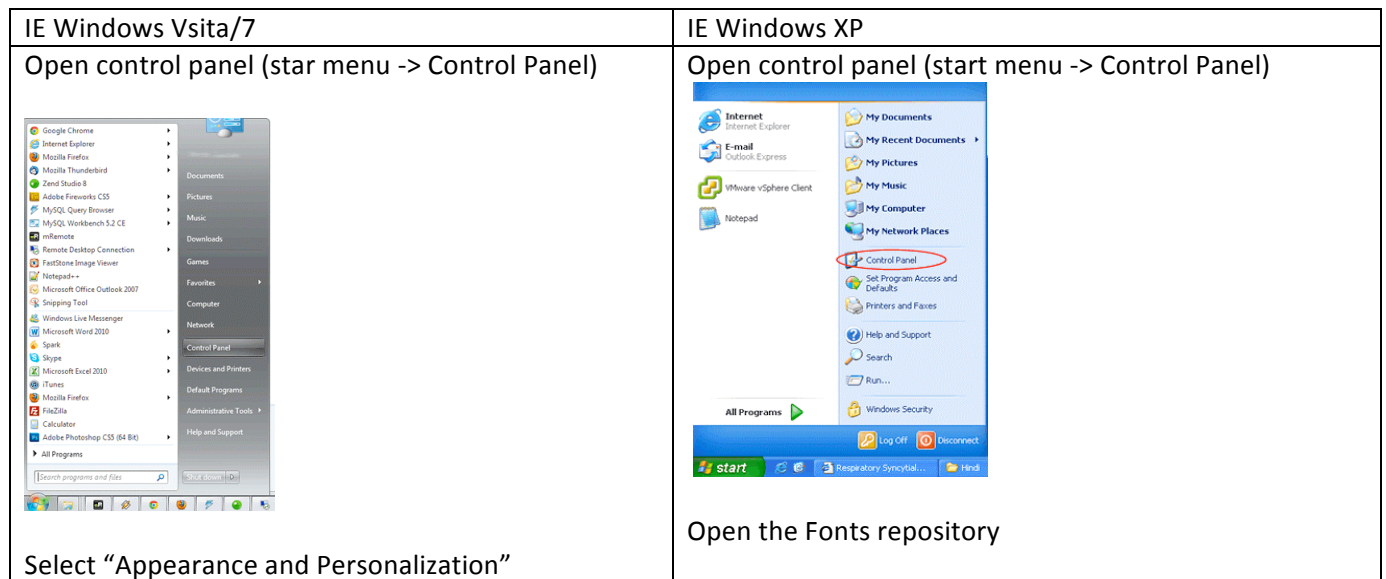


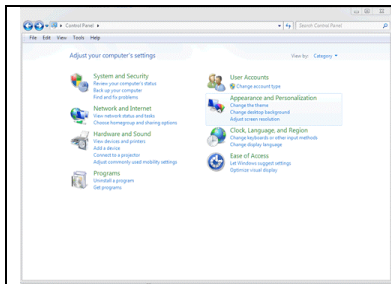
5. Select the folder where you want to extract the file.



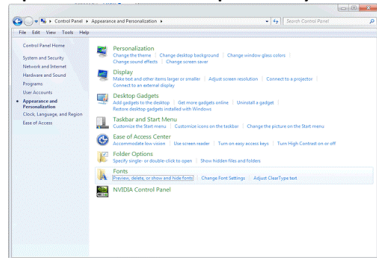
INSTALLING THE FONT

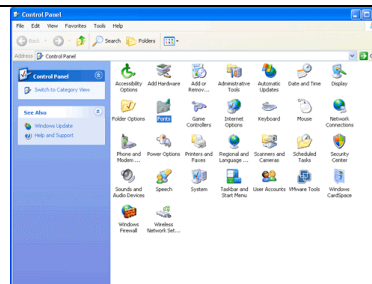




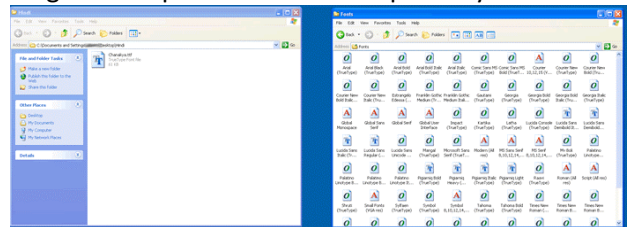
Open the Fonts repository



Drag and Drop the font to the repository



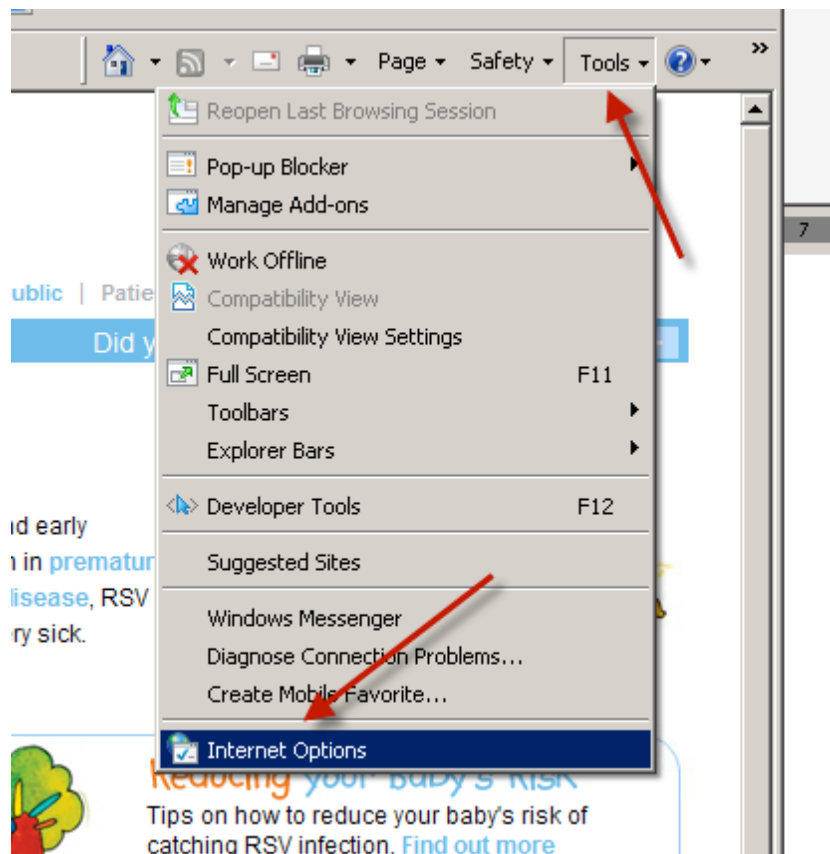
Drag and Drop the font to the repository



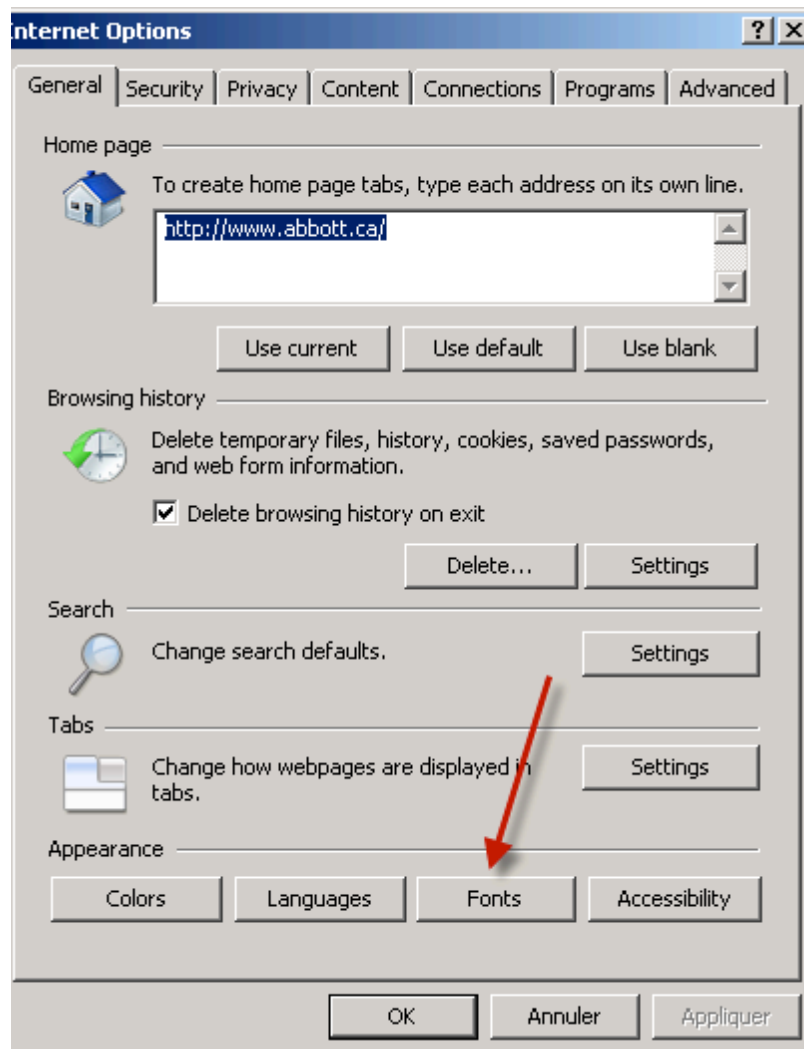
*If you are unable to open the font repository from the Start menu, double click on “My computer”, then double click on “local disk c”, then double click the “Windows” folder, then double click the “Fonts” folder. This is the fonts repository where you can copy the files you extracted earlier.

6. Restart your browser.

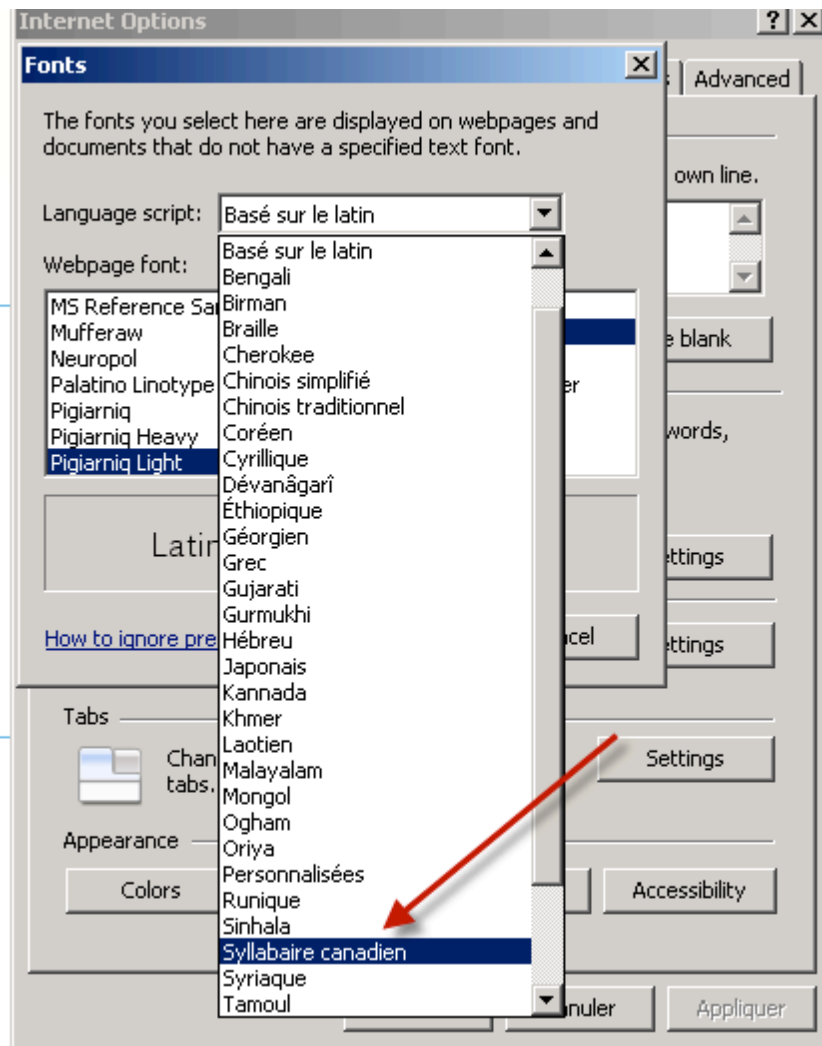
IMPORTANT NOTE: With Windows Explorer, it is possible that this new font does not work properly right away. If that’s the case, click on “Tools”, then on “Internet options”.



Then, select “Fonts”
